This podcast offers the host’s honest and blunt opinions on many different topics in finance that aim to help people learn to use their money in smart ways. The idea is that anyone can have control over their personal finances, all they have to do is be smart. The [Listen Money Matters website](#) also provides resources and lessons including ways to reach your career goals, make extra cash, free yourself of debt, and create budgets.

## **2. [Money For the Rest of Us](#)**

Financial expert [David Stein](#) hosts *Money For the Rest of Us* where he speaks about being smart with your investments and having enough to retire. This weekly podcast aims to teach people how to live their lives without having to worry about money. David Stein references how people can improve their “retirement IQ” and teaches lessons on wealth building and investing. #### **4. [Planet Money](#)**

National Public Radio's (NPR) *Planet Money* was launched in the midst of the 2008 financial crisis and has grown in popularity since, as it makes sense of the economy in simple and creative ways. The goal is to entertain while getting into the nitty-gritty of the forces that move our economic world. Planet Money is hosted twice weekly by a rotation of NPR journalists including, [Ailsa Chang](#), [Cardiff Garcia](#), [Jacob Goldstein](#), [Noel King](#), [Kenny Malone](#), [Robert Smith](#), and [Stacey Vanek Smith](#). The journalists also launched [The Indicator](#), which is a smaller more frequently released podcast on NPR.

While this podcast aims to provide helpful tips and insights for financial advisors, it also shares many business success stories from which to draw inspiration. Financial planner and host [Michael Kitces](#) began his podcast in January of this year and now has over 75 episodes. Kitces shares his passion for lifelong education and teaches advisors how they can continue to practice better ways to inform their clients. *Financial Advisor Success* plays weekly on Tuesday and features many other successful guest hosts in the finance industry. The website, [A Nerd's Eye View at Kitces.com](#) offers a variety of different services such as Michael's consulting services, public speaking, and blog.

#### **6. [The Investor's Field Guide: Invest Like the Best](#)**

The Investor's Field Guide is a website that features [Invest Like the Best](#), a podcast founded in September 2006 airing weekly on Tuesdays. The podcast offers an ongoing investigation and several different angles to succeed in the stock market. Host [Patrick O'Shaughnessy](#), CEO of [O'Shaughnessy Asset Management](#), speaks with interesting guests on his show each week, including investors, authors, portfolio managers, and even people outside of the investing business who can share their stories and insight.

#### **7. [Stacking Benjamins](#)**

[Joe Saul-Sehy](#) the founder and of [Stacking Benjamins](#) hosts this comical, yet informative, podcast from his mother's basement. Before *Stacking Benjamins*, Joe spent 16 years as a financial advisor and was known as the "Money Man" on Detroit's WXYZ-TV where he appeared twice a week. The show is known for its entertaining and informative interviews about various topics in the finance industry.

#### **8. [Smart Passive Income](#)**
